

EXPLANATION OF PROTECTIVE TARIFF OF 1828- NULLIFICATION CRISIS OF 1832

- ⦿ The regional conflict over tariffs was getting worse.
- ⦿ The northern states needed the tariff to keep foreign goods from being sold so cheap here that American companies would lose \$\$\$.
- ⦿ The southern states did not make their own goods and bought them from foreigners.
- ⦿ In **1828**, Congress passed a tariff the southern states called, **Tariff of Abominations**.
- ⦿ **Jackson's** V.P., **John C. Calhoun**, helped lead the southern states against the tariff.
- ⦿ Southern states believed in **states' rights**: the belief that states should be more powerful than the federal government.
