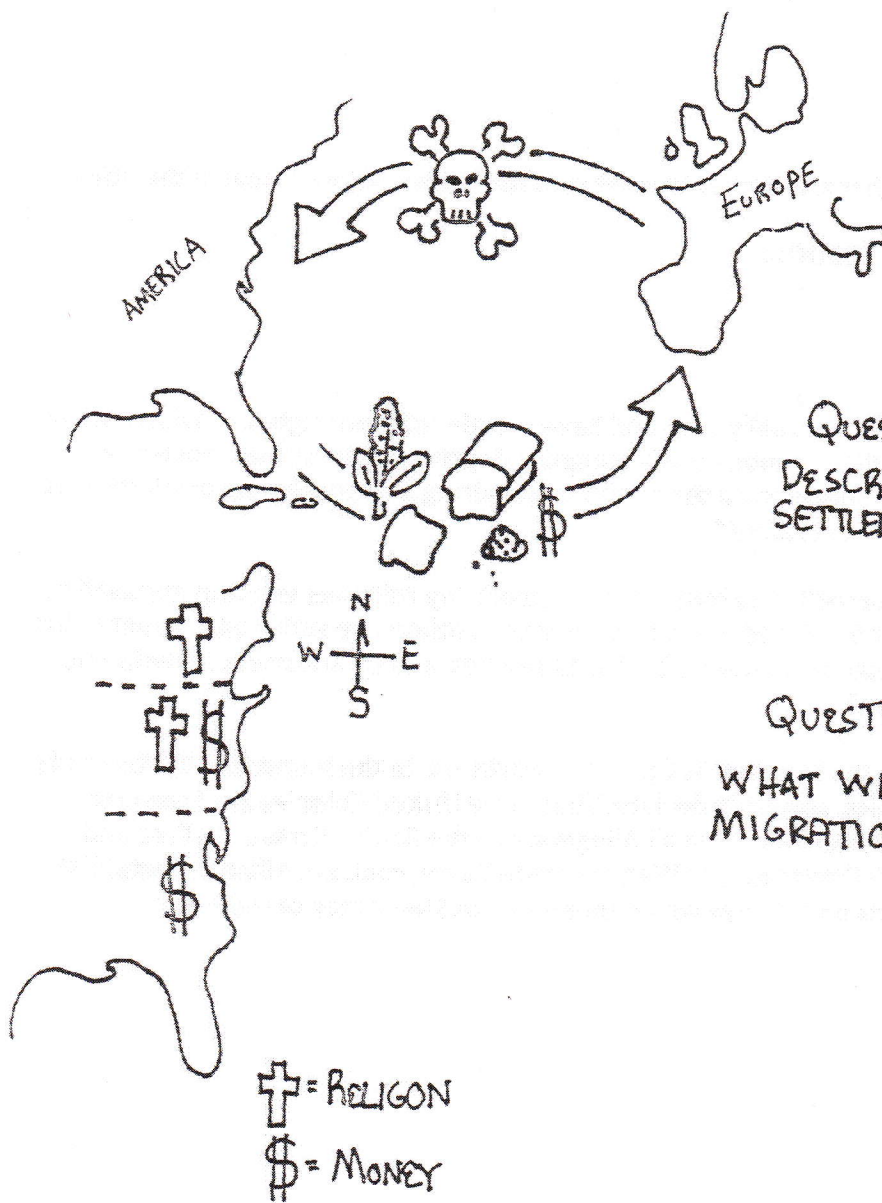
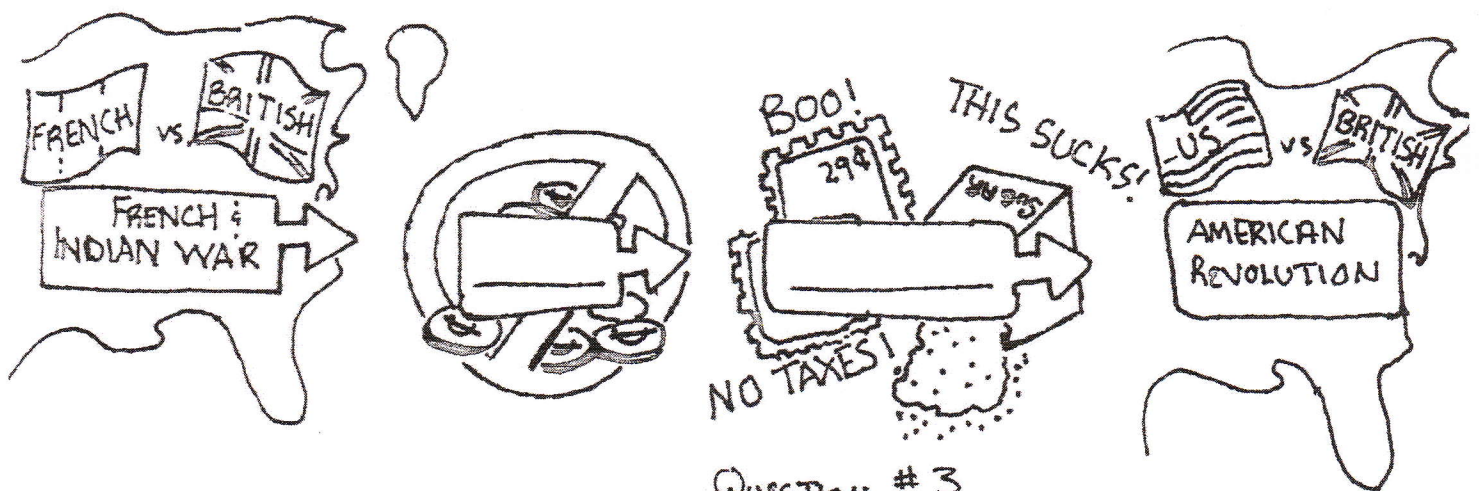

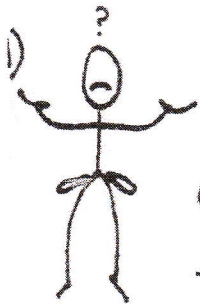

_____1. "That all men are by nature equally free, and have certain inherent rights, of which, when they enter into a state of society, they cannot, by any compact, deprive or divest their posterity; namely, the enjoyment of life and liberty, with the means of acquiring and possessing property, and pursuing and obtaining happiness and safety."

_____2. "That no man shall be compelled to frequent or support any religious worship nor shall be enforced, restrained, molested, or burdened in his body, nor shall otherwise suffer on account of his religious opinions or belief; but that all men shall be free to profess, and by argument to maintain, their opinion in matters of religion"

_____3. Therefore appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world, do, in the Name, and by Authority of the good People of these Colonies, solemnly declare, That these United Colonies are Free and Independent States; that they are Absolved from all Allegiance to the British Crown. As Free and Independent States, they have full Power to levy War, conclude Peace, contract Alliances, establish Commerce, and to do all other Acts and Things which Independent States may of right do."



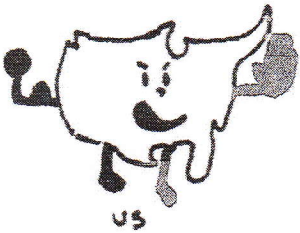

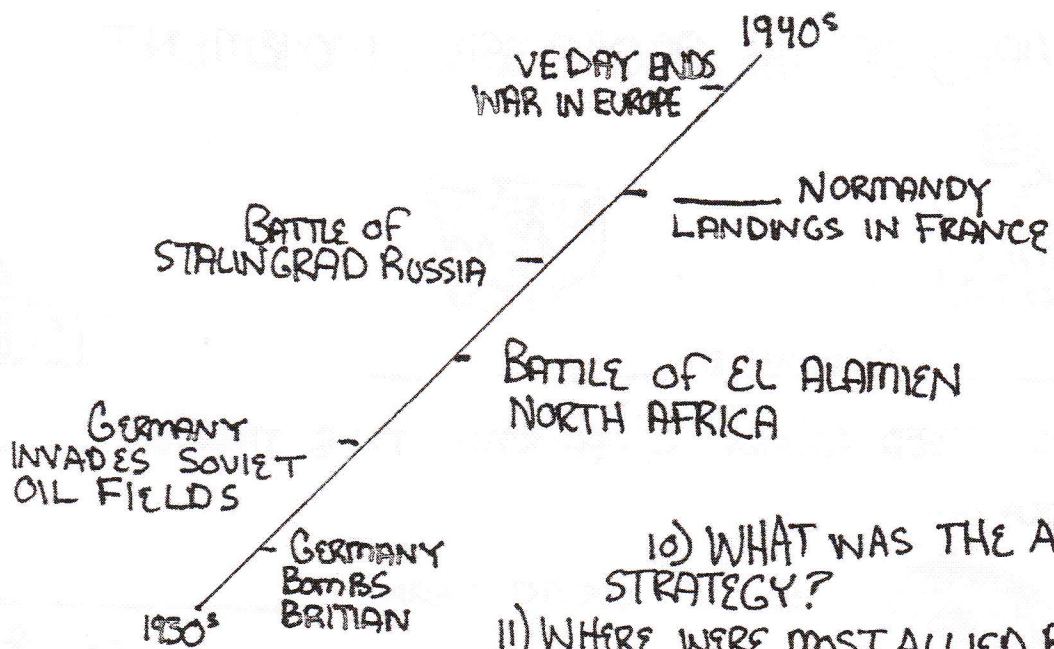
