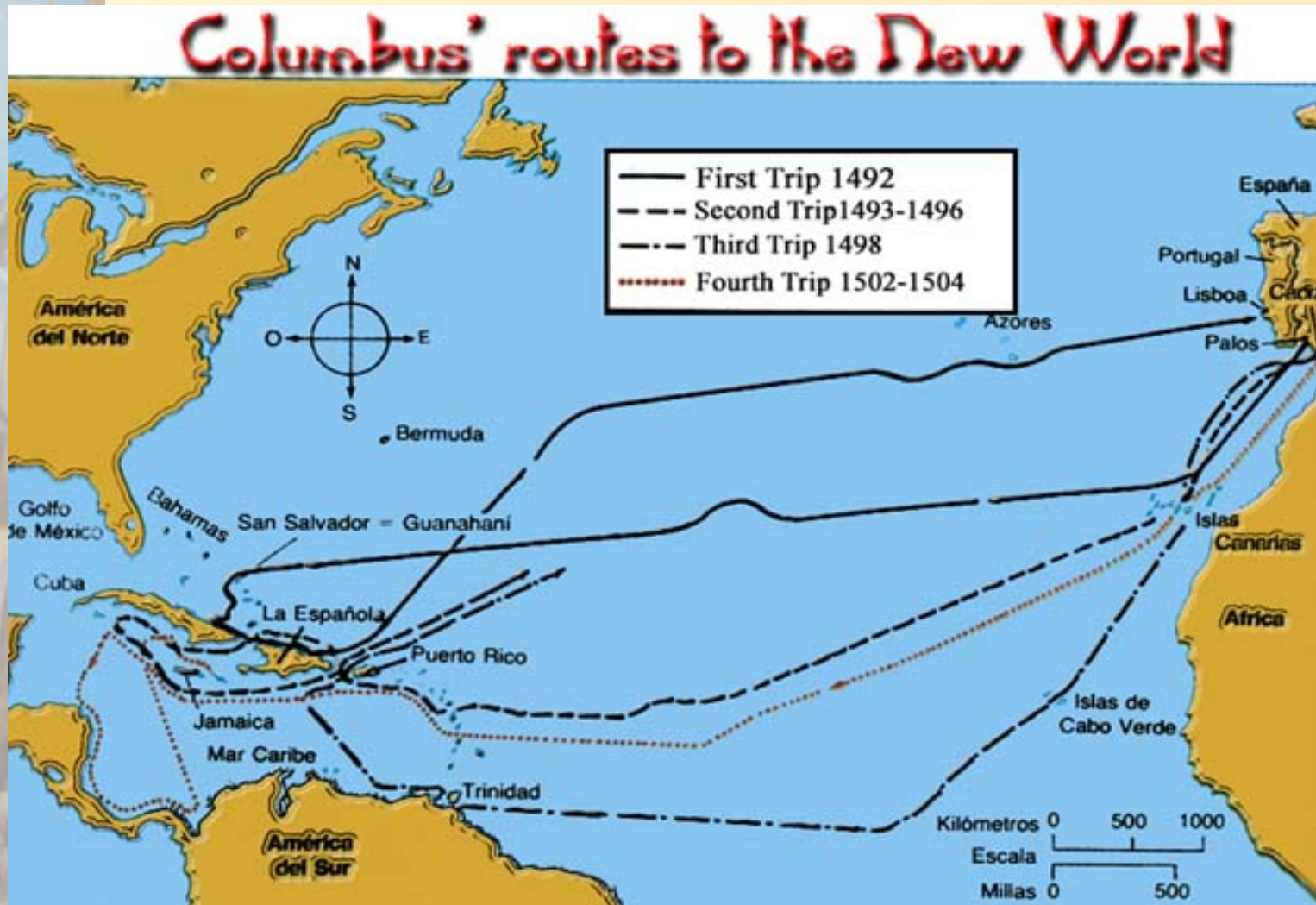

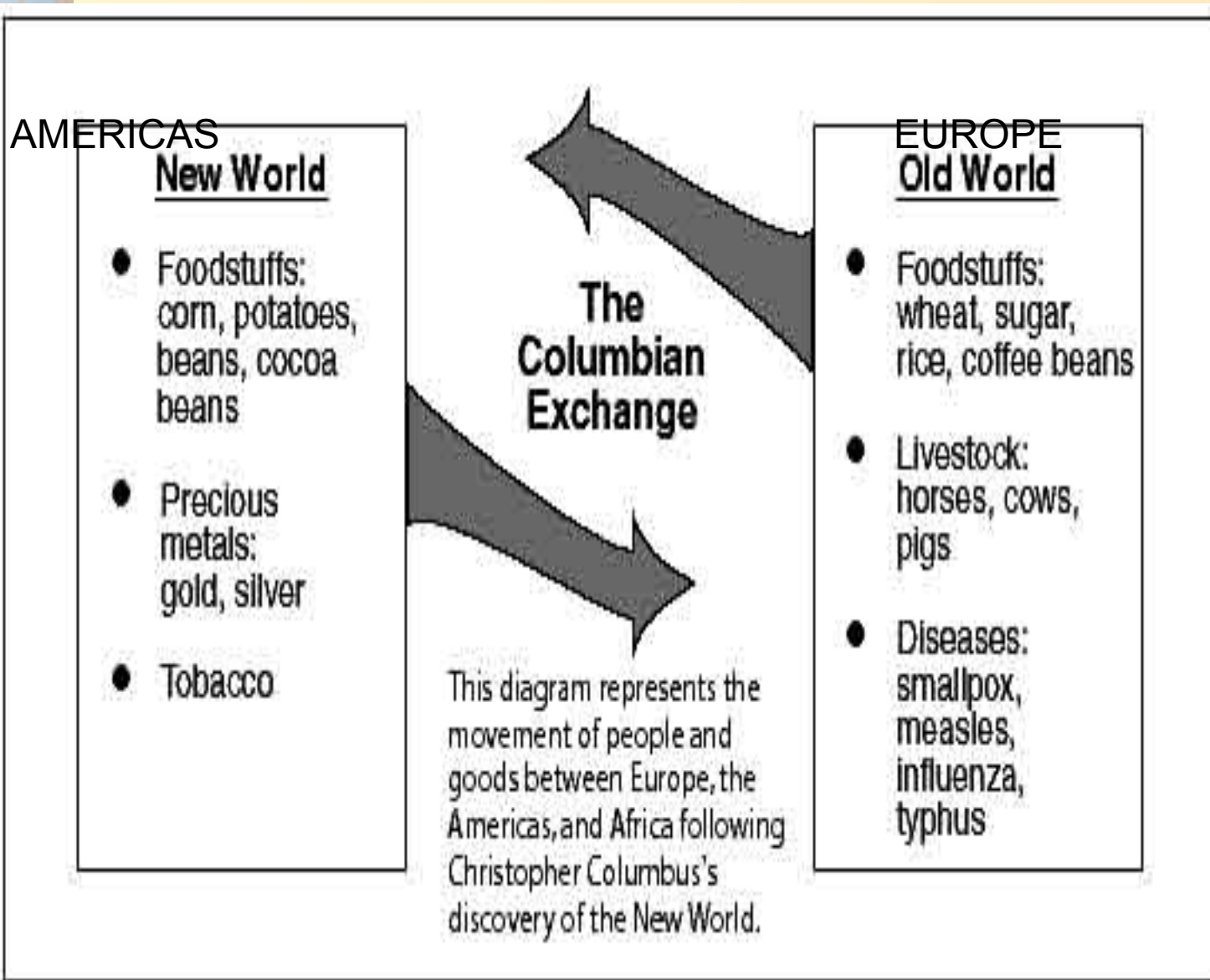




TRUTH ABOUT COLUMBUS

**SPANISH CONQUESTS

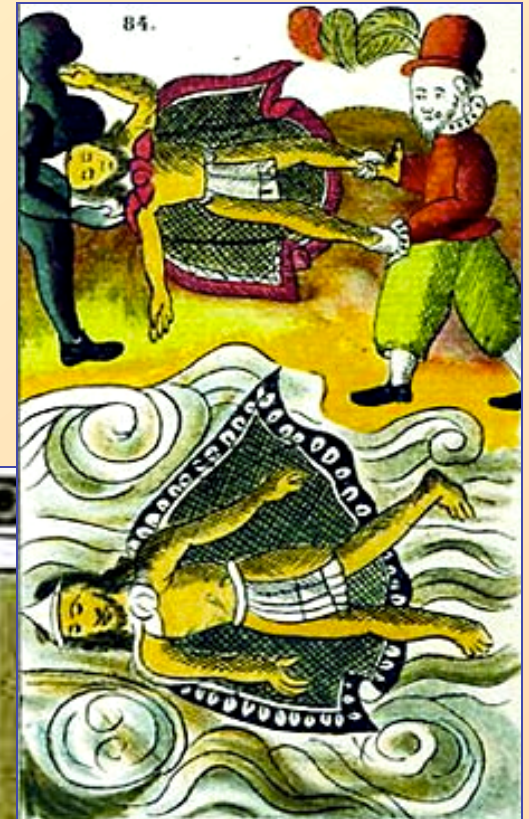
- CORTES DEFEATING THE AZTECS in **MEXICO**- 1519 (ALONG WITH COLUMBUS CONQUERING THE CARIBBEAN) IS THE BEGINNING OF THE EUROPEAN CONQUESTS AGAINST THE NATIVE PEOPLES OF NORTH AMERICA (INDIANS).
- DISEASES KILLED OFF MANY INDIANS.

Historic map of Florida

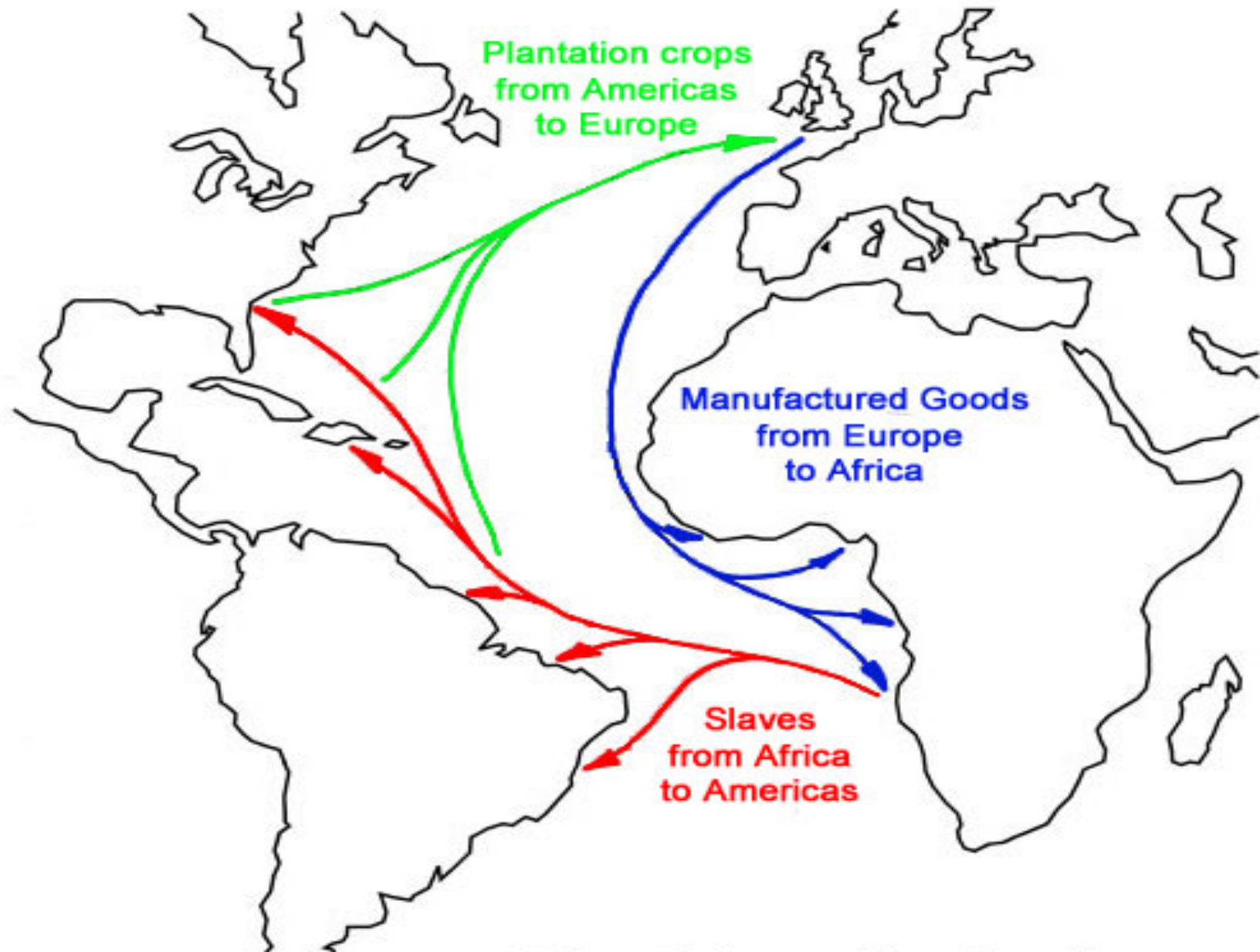


****IMPACT ON AFRICANS**

***FRENCH EXPLORATION

- By contrast, FRENCH exploration of Canada did not lead to large scale immigration from France, and relations with native peoples were better-helped with fur trade
