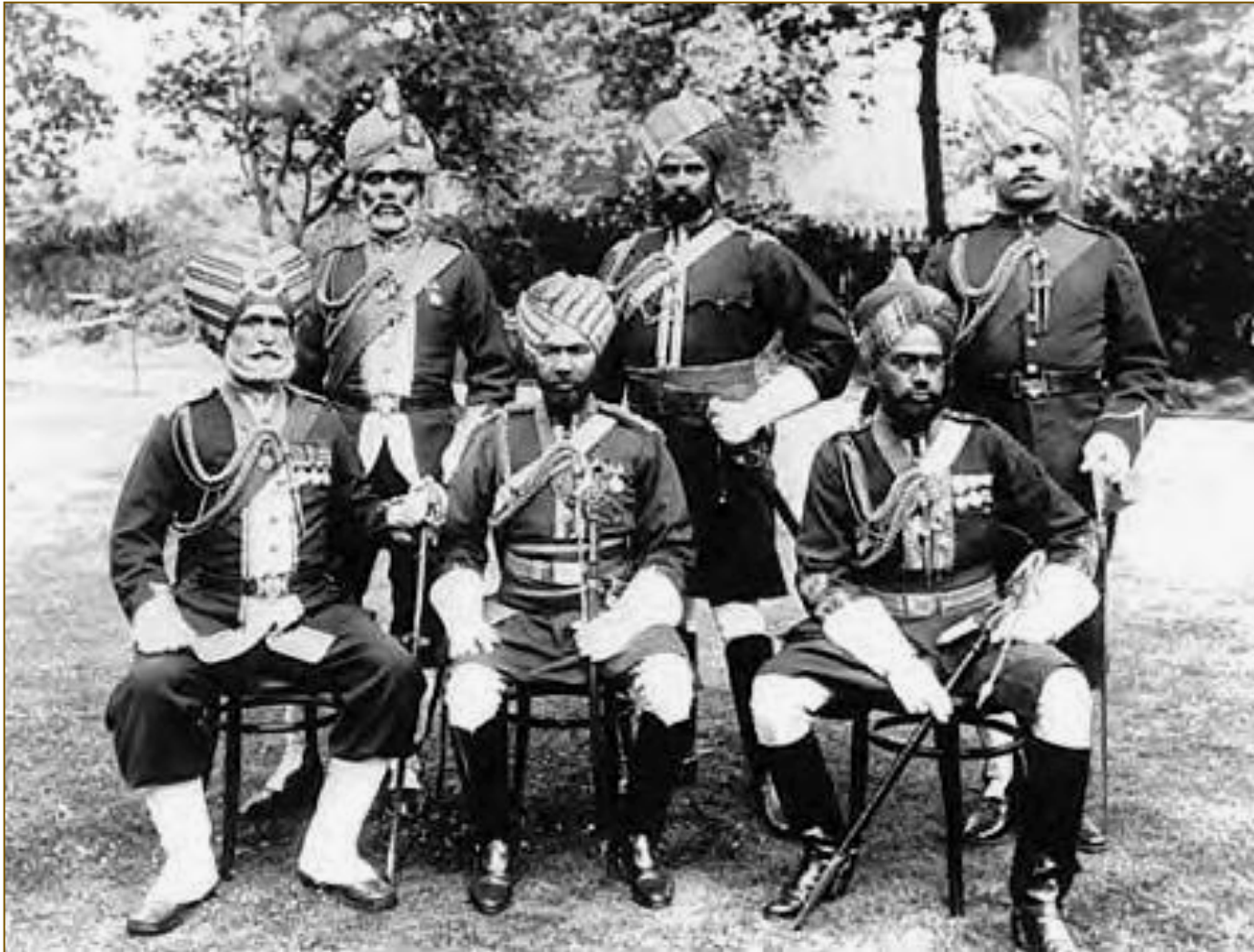


Results of the War

****Outcomes and global effects of World War I:**

- Colonies' participation in the war, increased demands for independence
- End of the **Russian Imperial, Ottoman, German, and Austro-Hungarian Empires.**
- Enormous **cost of the war** in lives, property, and social disruption. 37-40 million casualties.

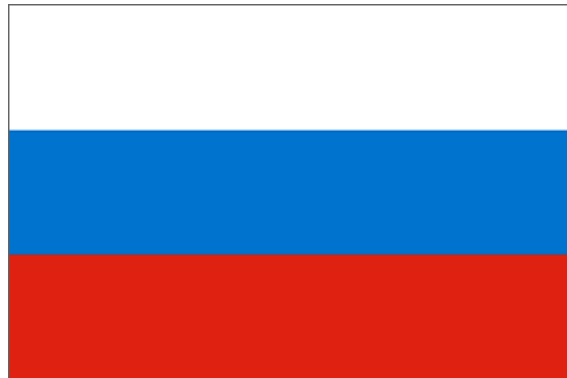
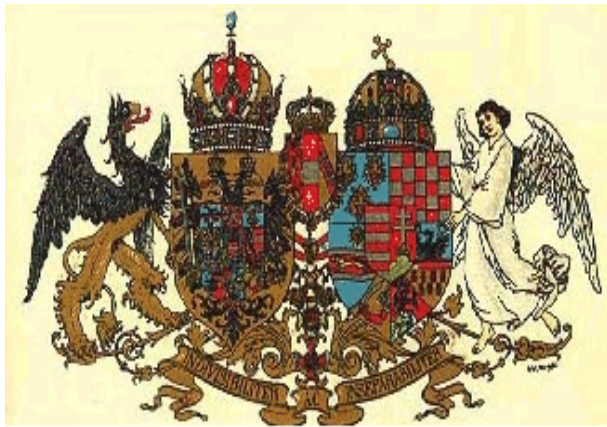

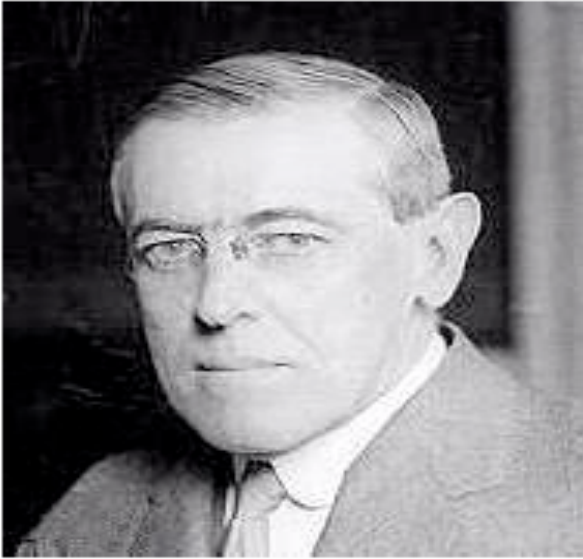

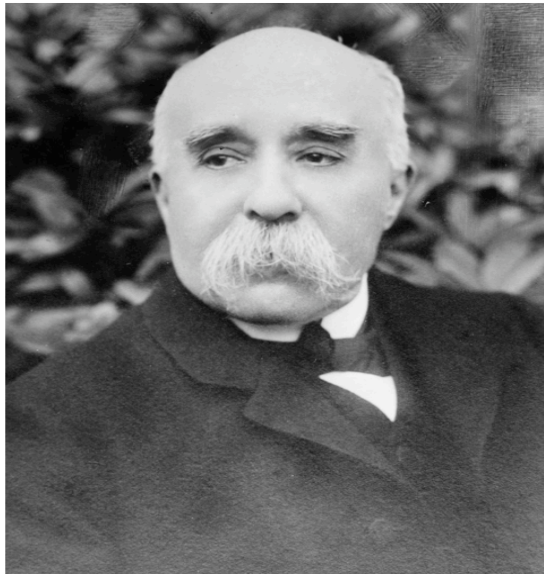
Treaty of Versailles, signed July 28, 1919



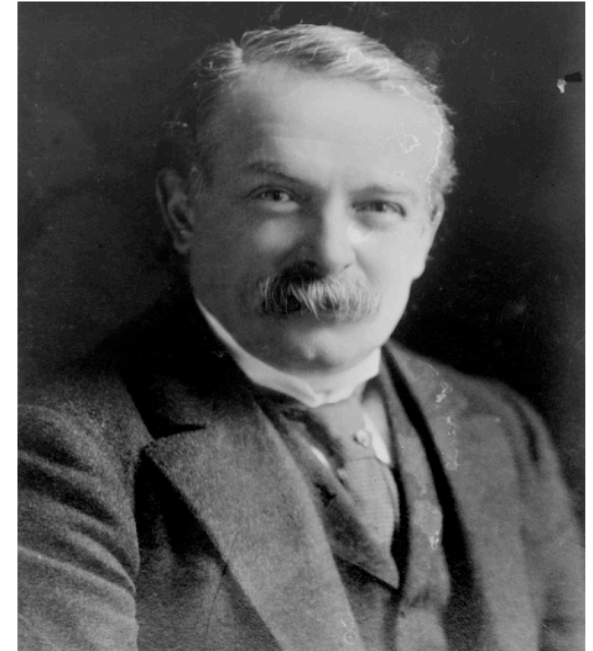
****The “Big Three” at the signing of the Treaty of Versailles, 1919**

1919-TREATY of VERSAILLES

- *Germany forced to accept the war guilt clause— total and sole guilt for causing the war
- **Germany** must **give up** some of its territory— especially the **Alsace-Lorraine** which they took from France during the Franco-Prussian War of 1871.
- Germany must pay war reparations
- Germany's military is severely limited
- **League of Nations**-international group of former Allied nations to try and stop future wars-no military power

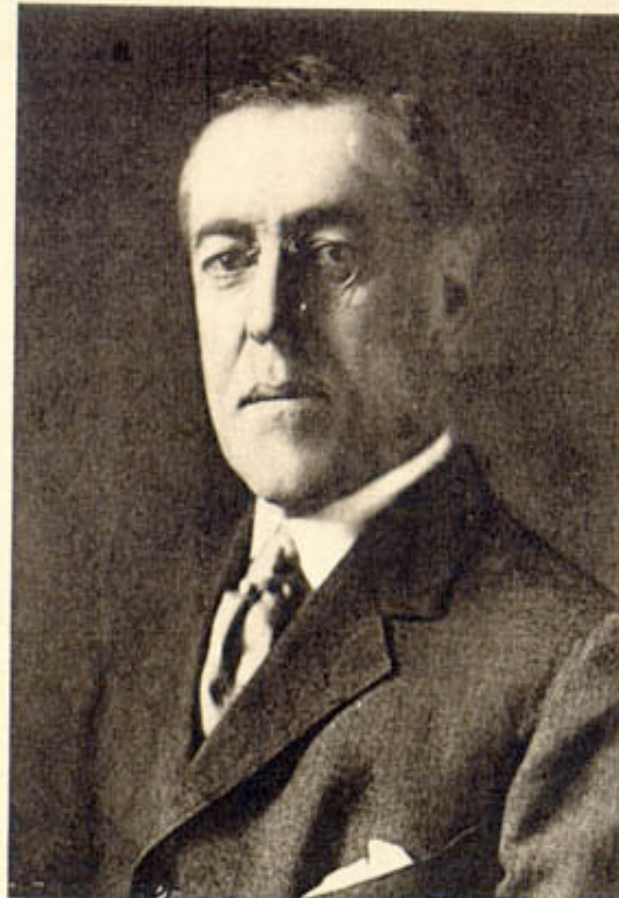
ORIGIN OF THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS

January 8th, 1918. Fourteen Points laid down by President Wilson as the basis of world peace. (*)

January 25th, 1919. League accepted in principle.

April 28th, 1919. Covenant adopted.

January 10th, 1920. League came into being; Secretariat established in London.

January 16th, 1920. First meeting of Council at Paris.

November 1st, 1920. League Headquarters moved from London to Geneva.

November 15th, 1920. First Meeting of Assembly at Geneva.

(*) THE FOURTEENTH POINT :

" A General Association of Nations must be formed under specific covenants for the purpose of affording mutual guarantees of political independence and territorial integrity to great and small States alike."
