

# TABLE GRAFFITI

This activity is an unconventional way to capture student thinking. You will need to use large pieces of butcher paper, markers, or different colored pens. Form a table of 3-5 students with one piece of butcher paper. Without talking, ask students to write their thinking in any random place on the paper (for lower grades, you might have students use magazine pictures to tape onto the paper). Students can write full sentences, phrases, questions, or responses. As they write (in silence), ask them to respond to some of their table mates' writing.

Each table's work may be a combination of words, pictures, sentences, paragraphs, responses, and ideas.
