





Library tour


This short session introduces students to the Library's services and facilities through a 15 -30 minute walking tour.

Information Literacy classes





 **How to use the NEW Library catalogue:** This session covers the use of the **new** TAFE NSW Library catalogue (from July 07). Topics covered include basic and power searching, viewing your own patron record and loan details and how to **renew items online**.

 **Research skills:** This session covers basic research skills such as understanding the assignment question, constructing a bibliography, searching the library catalogue, and locating appropriate library resources.

 **Finding statistics:** Statistical information in an assignment can provide evidence for arguments and make the work more persuasive and convincing. This session shows students how to locate relevant statistics using books, magazines, the internet and online databases.

 **Using online databases**
This session introduces students to the Library's range of online databases which provide access to full-text magazine and newspaper articles, as well as specialist information such as Australian standards. The session can cover one database in depth or briefly introduce a range of databases.

 **Using the Internet:** When used effectively, the internet can be a valuable source of quality information. This session provides an introduction to search engines and directories, internet search strategies, and how to evaluate the quality of internet information.

 **DET Portal:** Do your students know that they have a DET email account? Are they aware of the services available to them via the DET Portal? If not, they need to attend this workshop. Student will learn what the DET portal is, as well as how to access and use their Internet and email account.
