So long as he lived, Elder Brewster was the venerated "father in God" of the Plymouth Colony. During his last years Duxbury was his home and here he served actively as teacher until 1637.

Bradford's tribute to Brewster is one of the most beautiful passages in his history. "Haply more may be done hereafter", he says, as if challenging those who have followed. For some time now it has been the custom for the descendants of the families that have passed on the rich heritage of this ancient church, and all its friends, to gather at the Meeting House once each year and join in a service of commemoration.
