Rules Set for Beach Walkers

Town Clerk Nancy Oates urges those wishing to walk their dogs on the beach to bring proof by paper work or by the collar with the 2002 dog registration house tag to the receptionist at town hall for a permit.

The following rules are in effect on Duxbury Beach from April 1 through August 31:

- * A dog on Duxbury Beach properties shall be at all times leashed and under immediate and effective control of its handler.

- * Any person wishing to take a dog onto Duxbury Beach properties shall obtain a permit at town hall receptionist office with the proper collar tag or registration paperwork

- * If otherwise consistent with these rules dogs are allowed on the beach between 8 am and sunset unless the hours are amended by the harbormaster's department.

- * Any violation of the rules set forth in Article 37 of the 2002 Duxbury Annual Town Meeting (pooper scooper by-law) shall result in a non criminal citation of \$25.00 to \$200. payable by the handler of the dogs and the immediate revocation for the season of the applicable dog permit.

- * No dogs or their handlers are allowed in any protected areas at any time for any reason.

- * Dog handlers are required at all times of the year to remove droppings from the Powder Point Bridge, beach parking lots and all beach areas.

- * All dogs are prohibited from the front beach known as the resident beach south to the poles delineating the start of the 4x4 beach.

- * All dogs are prohibited from the back beach north of the Powder Point Bridge adjacent to the resident parking lot.
