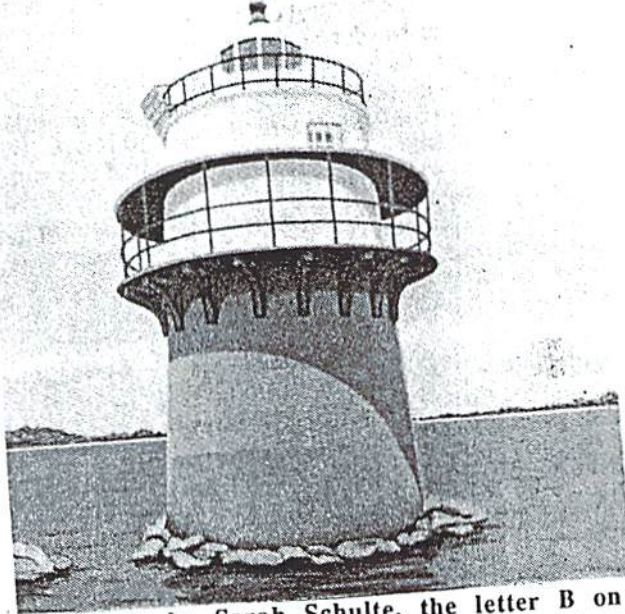




## Duxbury A to Z

How can you describe the scenic beauty, historic landmarks, and well-loved traditions of Duxbury in just 26 letters? The Duxbury Rural & Historical Society has done that on an exciting new poster, *Duxbury A to Z*. Artist Sarah Schulte of New York was commissioned to paint 26 Duxbury views for this poster, which is a fund raising project of the DR&HS. Schulte's graphic, contemporary style presents bold new images of familiar local scenes.

A is for the John Alden House, B is for Bug Light, C is for cranberries. The town pier, sailboats on the bay, the beach and Powder Point bridge represent the waterfront. North Hill golf course, Island Creek Pond, Old Burying Ground, 4th of July parade, Tinkertown luminaire at Christmas, Halls Corner, Snug Harbor, the Art Complex Museum and the Ellison Center for the Arts are included. Well-known landmarks are the Myles Standish Monument, First Parish Church, the library, both old & new, and the Winsor House. Others featured are DR&HS properties, the King Caesar House, Capt. Gershom Bradford House, Drew House and Round Pond trails.

*Duxbury A to Z* is a stunning work of art with 26 upbeat images that are fun, nostalgic, and delightful. The poster and the original paintings will be introduced at the Duxbury Art Assn's Midsummer art show on August 4, 5, 6. Posters will be available for sale at the show and at the Drew and King Caesar houses and at several local businesses beginning August 1. It will also be available by mail order.
