

In checking on the Baptismal Record of the first three pastors John Manion was found easy enough. And the archives had fortunately Timothy Howard from Malden at Sacred Heart . The only difficulty will be in tracing William Philip Conley born August 16, 1899 in Charlestown I must check either St. Mary's or St. Francis DeSales for the simple reason that the parish records that go back to 1899 have not been sent into the archives.

Also, there is no listing in the materials, that the diocese has, as to what parish they were baptised in.
