## Colonial Homes to Feature King Caesar House Christmas

Duxbury Rural & Historical Society Executive Director Marcia Solberg announced this week that *Colonial Homes* Magazine plans a 10-page full color spread during the holiday season featuring Christmas at Duxbury's King Caesar House.

"We are very excited about the feature. It's wonderful for us because it gives national exposure," she said.

"Duxbury: A Pilgrim Village" which included many historical sites in town including the Winsor House and Sun Tavern.

Solberg said after that, tourist traffic increased substantially at Duxbury's historical sites that summer.

For the past 2 years, photographer Darwin Davidson of Maine has been capturing the King Caesar Christmas decorations on film and will add this year's "Christmas Traditions: A Visit From St. Nicholas" to 1995 photos depicting, "A Currier & Ives Christmas" and 1996 photos of the King Caesar House's "Maritime Merriment".

Davidson has taken many photos for the *Colonial Homes*, which accepted his proposal for the feature on Christmas at Duxbury's King Caesar House, Solberg said.

Plans call for extending the visiting hours this year from noon to 5 pm from Dec. 11 to Dec. 16.

Solberg credited DR&HS President Judy Hall with securing Duxbury's first spread in the magazine and said she plays a big role in plans for the upcoming feature along with the nearly 75 volunteers who help design and decorate the historic home.
