

DHS grads charged in break-in

Two recent Duxbury High School graduates were arrested last week for allegedly breaking into the high school concession stand.

Craig Sullivan of Alexander Way and George Dane Molina of Washington Street, both 18, were charged with breaking and entering in the daytime, attempting to commit a felony larceny, malicious damage to property and being a minor in possession of alcohol.

According to Lt. Lewis Chubb of the Duxbury Police Department, witnesses allegedly saw the two teens kick in the service window in the front of the concession stand around 7:45 a.m. Thursday, June 12, and called the police. The police were able to locate Molina and Sullivan based on the eyewitnesses' description and the physical evidence from the concession stand, Chubb said.

The concession stand is behind the high school in the rear parking lot by the football stadium.

Chubb said the department is investigating a possible stolen item, but he could not comment further because the incident is still under investigation.

Molina and Sullivan are due in Plymouth District Court July 17.
