

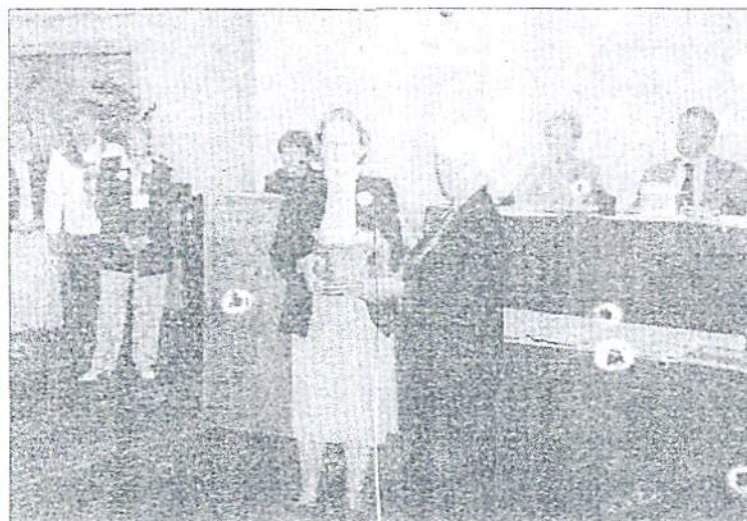


Wildflowers Wins Awards
