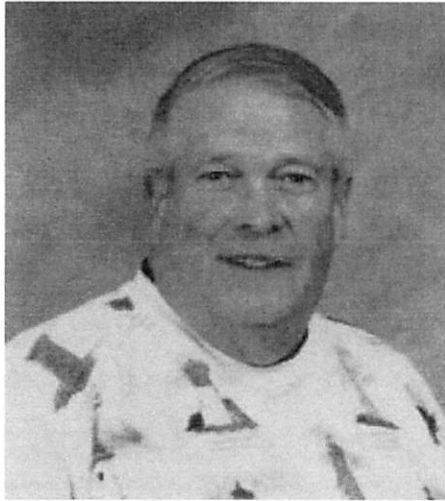


## David M. Freeman, 79
