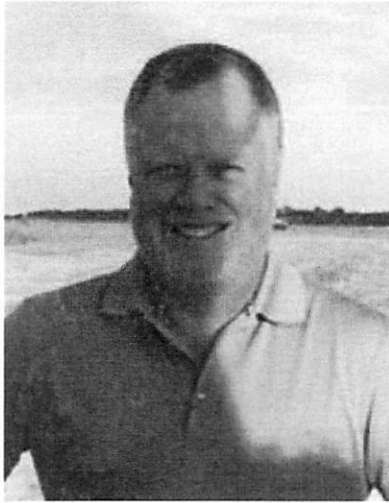


David William Fahy, 52
