The Duxbury Free Library signed a contract recently with a local bakery to run a small cafe in the town's new library.

French Memories, a Snug Harbor bakery, was chosen to run a small eatery at the library. The cafe will serve coffee and hot beverages along with an assortment of pastries and sweets.

The new space will not be ready for full-time operation until the beginning of January, but the cafe will begin serving on a part-time basis beginning Nov. 24.
