

Rose event helps maritime school blossom



An estimated 8,000 people visited Snug Harbor over the weekend to tour the HMS Rose and learn more about the Duxbury Bay Maritime School.

"HMS" Rose is scheduled to sail into Snug Harbor in Duxbury at 3:15 p.m. Friday. Receptions aboard the ship on Friday and Saturday nights, benefits for Duxbury Bay Maritime Center, are sold out.

However, the public can tour the Rose on Saturday, 10 a.m.-3 p.m., and Sunday, noon-3 p.m. The charge is \$5 per person, with a \$10 maximum for a family. Other Snug Harbor events Saturday, including performances by the

Duxbury High School marching band and the Duxbury-based group Watson Reid & Americana, are free.

Parking will be available at Duxbury High School on Saturday and Sunday, with free shuttle service to Snug Harbor.

Rose is expected to depart late Sunday afternoon or at dawn on Monday, bound for New York City and a parade of sail up the Hudson River.
