Hit and run

Bicyclist recovering after weekend accident

Duxbury police are investigating a hit and run accident that occurred over the weekend on Tremont Street. According to police, the crash occurred shortly before 3 p.m. on Saturday afternoon near The Marshes. Witnesses said a bicyclist traveling north on Tremont Street was struck by a northbound vehicle. The bicyclist then hit a utility pole on the shoulder of the road. The cyclist, David Grossman, was taken by helicopter to a Boston hospital. His injuries are non-life threatening.

The operator of the car did not stop and was last seen heading north on Route 3A toward Marshfield.

Duxbury Police crash investigation unit, and detective divisions are actively investigating the crash.

According to police, the vehicle is an older blue or grey Jeep Cherokee that may have minor damage to the passenger side.
