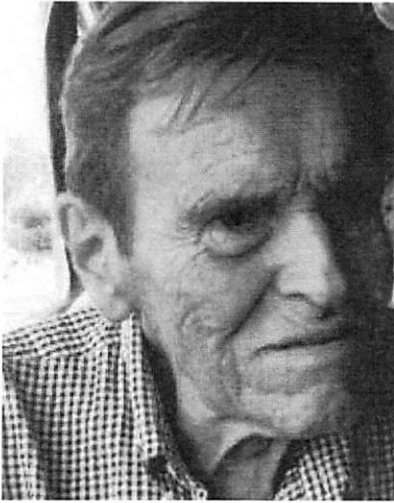


## John Derden “Jack” Osborn, 95
