MARSHALL JOYCE

Marshall Joyce, 86, of Kingston, died at his home.

Nationally recognized as a seascape artist, Joyce has paintings in many permanent collections, including the Peabody Museum in Salem, the Museum of the South in Mobile Alabama, and the Museum of Fine Arts in Anchorage Alaska. Several years ago he was commissioned by Plimoth Plantation to do the official painting of the Mayflower.

Mr. Joyce was a member of the American Society of Marine Artists, International Marine Artist, New England Society of Watercolor, Rockport Art Assn, and the Guild of Boston.

He leaves his wife of 60 years Marion and his 2 daughters, Marsha Joyce of Portsmouth, NH and Bonnie Allen of Kingston; 5 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at Pilgrim Church, Washington St. at 11 am on Saturday, Feb. 14.
