Mrs. Simcock has just told me, when I showed her the picture of the ice on Duxbury beach, following the storm of 1898, that three of her father's brothers were drowned when the beach at the North River, Marshfield, broke through in the same storm. Her uncles were at a gunning shack at the time; besides this loss of life, two boys from Scituate and one from Humarock perished.
