

THE MAYFLOWER

THE PASSENGER LIST, 1620

With all known details of dates, occupations, place of origin and other information about the men, women and children who sailed with her.

Besides a crew of some fifty men, *Mayflower* carried just over 100 passenger intending to settle in Virginia. The ship was greatly overcrowded, for she had taken on many of the original Pilgrims from Holland, whose ship *Speedwell* had foundered after leaving Southampton. Many passengers, designated as Saints, were members of a separatist religious group led by William Brewster from Scrooby and supported by recruits from nearby towns of Yorkshire and Nottinghamshire. Their praying and psalm-singing aggravated many of the Strangers, who

were mostly artisans, soldiers and servants, but by the end of the arduous voyage all were united and ready to face more rigours together as the "Pilgrim Fathers." The survival in New England was, indeed, as hard as survival at sea, and within a year about half the colonists had died, many of the epidemic known as the "general sickness." Others returned to England years later, perhaps to their original homes, which are indicated in the following list, together with all known details of the men, women and children who set sail in the *Mayflower* in 1620.
