Being Exhibited

At Bumpus Gallery

DUXBURY — The prints and drawings of Harold Tovish are being exhibited in the Helen Bumpus Gallery of the Duxbury Free Library through Dec. 4. The public is invited to meet the artist at the opening from 4 to 6 p.m. Sunday.

Mr. Tovish, who teaches sculpture and drawing at Boston University, is a member of the Boston Visual Artists Union and is represented by the Alpha Gallery in Boston. He has also taught at Alfred University, Alfred, New York; University of Minnesota; School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston; University of Hawaii; and the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture.

His one-man shows have been exhibited at Walker Art Center, Minneapolis, Minnesota; Swetzoff Gallery, Boston; Terry Dintenfass, New York City; Fairweather-Hardin Gallery, Chicago; Addison Gallery of American Art, Andover; Alpha Gallery, Boston; Watson Gallery, Wheaton College, Norton Mass.; and the Solomon Guggenheim Memorial Museum, New York City.

His work was exhibited in the Venice Biennial in 1956, in addition to group shows in Helsinki, Brussels, Paris and Rome.

The Helen Bumpus Gallery is open from 10 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday, and from 1 to 5 p.m. Sunday.

Tovish, who teaches sculpture and drawing at Boston University, is a member of the Boston Visual Artists Union and is represented by the Alpha Gallery in Boston.

He has been awarded the following grants: a Guggenheim Fellowship; National Institute of Arts and Letters; Sculptor in Residence, American

Academy in Rome; and a Fellowship, Center for Advanced Visual Studies, MIT.

His one-man shows have been exhibited at Walker Art Center, Minneapolis, Minn.; Swetzoff Gallery, Boston; and Terry Dintenfass, New York City; among others.

Tovish, who lives in Brookline, is married to artist Marianna Pineda, who also exhibited at the library earlier this year. The Helen Bumpus Gallery is open Monday through Thursday, 10-9; Saturday, 10-5, and Sunday, 1-5.

Local Artists To Be Exhibited At Library

DUXBURY — Duxbury artists are offered the opportunity to exhibit in the third annual Local Artists Group Show in the Helen Bumpus Gallery of the Duxbury Free Library starting the second week of January.

In announcing the exhibition, library director Janie Neubauer reported that there would be a change this year in procedure, recommended by library art adviser Gay Youse and the gallery art advisory committee, designed to open the exhibition to more artists.

There will be no private in-

vitations to show this year. All entries will be selected by an outside juror, an artist not connected with the town of Duxbury. Entries are encouraged from all professional and serious amateur artists living in Duxbury.

One entry will be accepted from each artist unless the entry is oversized; in that case, an alternate choice should be provided. Entries will be accepted in the library the week of January 1. The exhibition will be arranged and hung by Miss Youse.
