DUXBURY RFD IS EXTENDED

Effective immediately, rural mail delivery will be extended to cover the following streets in Duxbury:

Bow St., traveling from West St. to Tremont.
Union St., between Penny Lane and Cross St.
Temple St., traveling from Church St. to #103 and retracing.
Peterson Rd., traveling from Weston Rd. to Upland Rd.
Upland Rd., traveling from East to West.
Penny Lane, traveling from Union St. to Candlewick Close.
Candlewick Close, from the end to Union St.
Clearwater Drive, Hallsbrook Way and Clover Circle, please ask at the Post Office for direction of travel.
Parkview Terrace, from Kingstown Way to end and retrace.
Harvest Drive, from Kingstown Way to end and retrace.
Buckboard Rd., traveling North to South direction.
Trout Farm Rd., from South St. to end and retrace.
Mullins Ave., from Bay Rd. to Pilgrim Rd. and retrace.

NOTE WELL

Customers living in these areas and wishing delivery are asked to check with the Post Office regarding rules governing placement of boxes and to fill out necessary forms.
