## Senior Center Building Update

Now that ground has been broken for the new Duxbury Senior Center, the long awaited construction process will begin with building completion scheduled for the end of March 2001. With this first Progress Report and with other reports through the coming months, we intend to provide the residents of Duxbury with information about significant construction events as they occur and on events one might expect to witness in the future.

This week, the temporary construction sign will be relocated from its present position, near the future site of the Senior Center and used only for the ground breaking ceremony, to a position near the corner of Mayflower and Tremont Streets where it will be more visible. Also, expect to see the removal of trees from the areas of the building footprint, driveway and parking lot. Every effort will be made, with the assistance of Peter Buttkus and Joe Grady, to assure that only the trees necessary for construction will be removed. The contractor has a long personal relationship with the town of Duxbury and is very sensitive to the concerns of its residents in this regard.

The coming weeks will be alive with activity as the project begins to take shape. The site will be graded to allow the installation of the building footings and the pouring of the first floor slab. Then the building will begin to appear. This is an exciting period for the town, and we want you to share it with us and to watch us grow.
