Car Accident Damages Standish Cemetery

A speeding car crashed into the Standish Cemetery on Chestnut Street early Saturday morning, taking out wooden fence posts, trees, and damaging gravestones.

A car driven by John Feloney, 21, of Weymouth

was allegedly speeding down Chestnut Street at 2:13 a.m., according to Lt. Lewis Chubb of the Duxbury Police. Feloney lost control of the car near the intersection with Pilgrim By-Way and careened into the cemetery, striking a fence post and then hitting a tree.

Feloney and one passenger were taken to Jordan Hospital. Police charged Feloney with negligent operation of a motor vehicle, speeding and a marked lanes violation, Chubb said.
