Surplus St. Field Protected

Selectmen voted unanimously to accept a conservation restriction on an acre on Surplus St.

The land is an open field owned by Kay and Charles Foster of Surplus St. and it borders their land. It will have a conservation restriction placed on it with the Wildlands Trust of South-

eastern Mass., according to Pat Loring, Open Space Committee chair and conservation activist. This will protect this open vista from development. It may be used for some agriculture, such as an orchard or for horses. The acre used to be owned by the Cotter family. Loring said this conservation restriction joins others on Surplus St.
