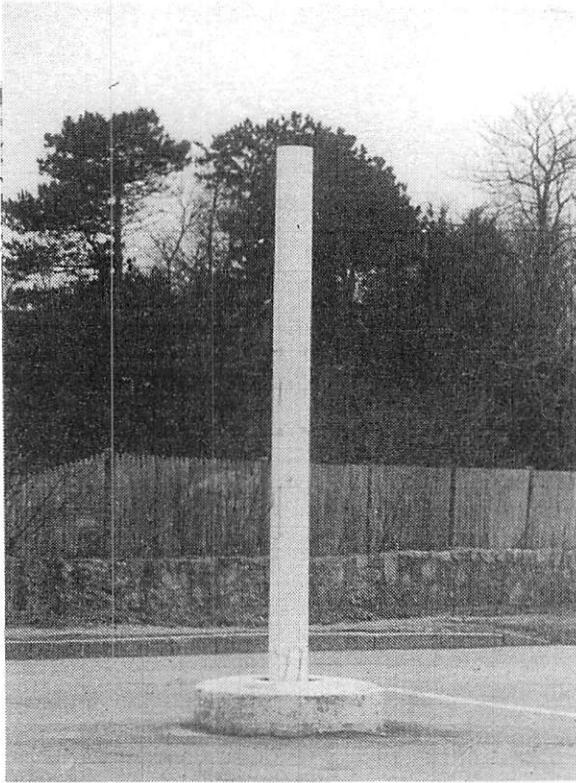


"Gone With The Wind

The wild and windy weather last week caused the flagpole on St. George St. to snap.

Windy Weather Snaps St. George St. Flagpole

Winds of up to 60 mph downed trees and branches causing power outages around town last Thursday.

Windy weather more than a week ago, blew down the flagpole on St. George St., snapping the fiberglass structure, which has several sections and shattering the sleeve that had connected the broken sections.

The pole is being repaired but no date has been given for its return.

Harbormaster Donald Beers who is custodian of the town's 4 flags, said flag flying has been limited during this very windy winter.
