Duxbury chosen as 'Good Kids' film set

Selectmen approve event permit

This week movie producers received the green light from the town to begin filming a new Hollywood movie at private residences on Powder Point, Washington Street and at Duxbury beach. Monday, the Board of Selectmen unanimously granted an event permit to the producers of the film "Good Kids," which will be filming at various locations around town beginning Thursday.

The movie is a teenage coming of age comedy directed by writer Chris McCoy and starring Nicholas Braun, Zoey Deutch, Craig Roberts, and Israel Broussard, according to The Hollywood Reporter website. The movie is

about "four overachieving high-school students living on Cape Cod who, upon graduating from high school, realize that they've missed out on key life experiences by always being the good kids and decide to reinvent themselves," states this website.

Selectmen Chairman Shawn Dahlen recused himself from the vote on the event permit because the movie will be filming at his house, 60 Long Point Lane, which is on Duxbury Bay.

Other locations include two private residences on King Caesar Road and another on Washington Street close to Snug Harbor. The movie will also shoot footage at the Harbormaster's shack at the entrance to Duxbury beach and on the beach access ramp.

Filming will also take place at the tennis courts at the Duxbury Yacht Club and at Osborn's Country Store on Summer Street and driving shots around town. The movie production company's schedule shows filming taking place beginning Sept. 11 and ending Sept. 29.

The cost of an event permit for filming a movie in Duxbury is \$30, the same as any other event permit. When asked if the town had considered increasing the rates charged for movie productions in Duxbury, Town Manager RenReed said he was looking into a new rate structure.
