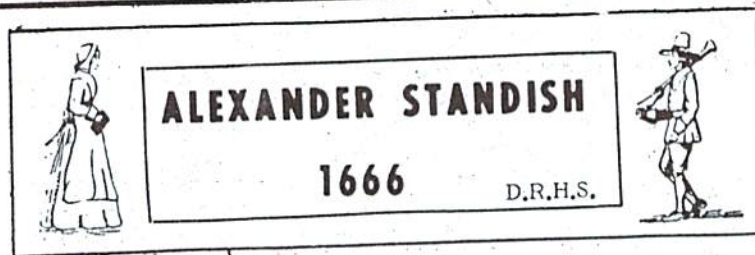


*Historical houses - NAMED, M-2*

The Alexander Standish House on Standish Shore is owned by David L. Patten. It is on part of the Captain Myles Standish Farm. In 1656, Alexander, eldest son of the Captain, inherited his father's house and lands.

According to tradition, the house burned within a few years; and Alexander built again a short distance to the west, in about 1666.

Ever since the house has been called the Alexander Standish House. The entire property of 120 acres remained in the Standish family, and passed down by inheritance until a great-grandson in 1763 sold it out of the family.

The date board, which will be documented and officially placed on this historic house, is contained in the top panel.
