



Bay Players Presents Story Theatre

For their July presentation, the Bay Players will present *Story Theatre*, a compilation of Grimm Brother's Tales and Aesop's Fables. Stories covered in this collection include *Henny Penny*, *The Bremen Town Musicians* and *The Golden Goose*.

Although *Story Theatre* is not geared towards being a production for children, it is unquestionably suitable for all ages and certain to delight families. Director Bern Budd envisions a circus-like atmosphere combined with audience interaction. *Story Theatre* will be a traveling show, presented in 3 towns over 3 weekends. Like thespians of yore, the troupe will enter the venue and upon seeing a crowd gathered, will erect their set right before the audience's eyes, and much like a circus tent raising, all part of the show.

Story Theatre will open in Duxbury at Duxbury High School's Good Knight Theatre on Friday, July 10, at 8 pm and will be repeated on Saturday, July 11. The show then travels to Ventress Memorial Library in Marshfield as part of their Performing Arts Series '98 on July 18 at 8 pm and on July 19 at 7 pm. Final location will be Memorial Hall in Plymouth, where 2 evening performances will be held at 8 on Friday and Saturday, July 24 and 25, closing with a matinee on July 26 at 2.

Director Bern Budd is the producer and director of original radio plays for broadcast on TIC, the Marshfield radio reading service for the print handicapped. He is active in acting, set design and construction with Bay Players and the North River Community Theatres.
