DUXBURY.- At the town meeting held last Saturday to see what action the town would take with regard to Blue Fish River Bridge, Capt. H.B. Maglathlin was chosen moderator. The present bridge it seems was constructed of wood in 1850, at a cost of \$1485. It is now in need of repairs. To reconstruct it of

wood, it is thought by some, may require from \$2000 to \$3000, and of stone and wood a somewhat larger sum. The meeting appointed the selectmen a committee to take into consideration the whole matter, and to report at an adjourned meeting to be held at 3 o'clock on Saturday.
