

## Car crash leads to drug arrest

Duxbury police officers responding to an early morning motor vehicle crash at Church and Tremont Streets seized drugs and cash from the vehicle and arrested a Pembroke man and charged him with multiple drug and motor vehicle crimes. While searching the vehicle, Duxbury police found several kinds of illegal drugs including cocaine, methamphetamines, marijuana and hashish, packaging supplies and over \$20,000 in cash.

Police seized all of the items and filed additional
