The estate was once home to Duxbury's most prosperous ship-builder and merchant. Each year teams of local decorators fill the stately rooms of this mansion with vignettes of holiday cheer. Decorators will feature historical artifacts in their schemes.

Integral to the event's theme is the Society's collection of historic costumes. Often used for the Christmas event with charming results, the historic costumes will this year become the centerpieces of the décor in each room. Decorators will be challenged with creating a holiday scene from the past (with costumed mannequins playing the parts of residents and guests of the house) as though we are glimpsing a moment in time.

This event will feature a unique gift shop offering ship portraits, jewelry, topiaries and other unique gifts for sale.
