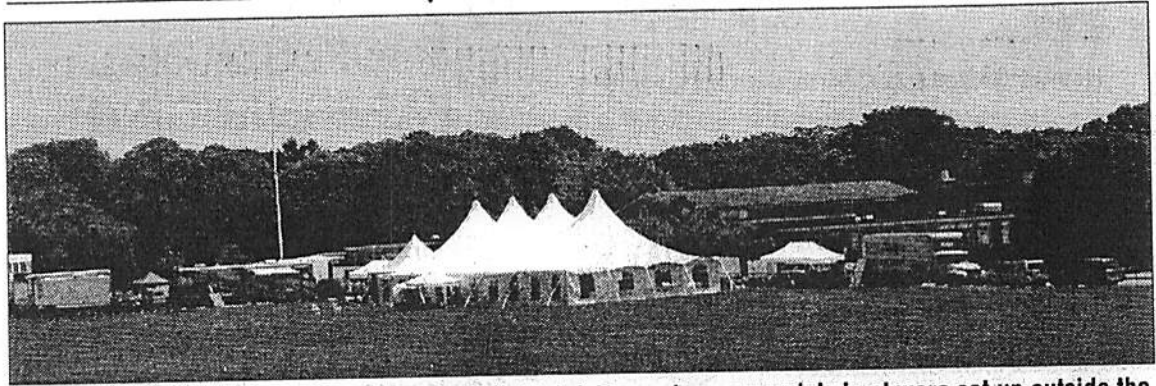

Commercial shoot takes over middle school & field

Hollywood came to Duxbury this week – albeit temporarily.

Selectmen, at their meeting on Thursday June 7, voted to grant an event permit to Little Bear Inc. The production company filmed mainly at a private residence on Standish Street,

but maintained a “base camp” at Duxbury Middle School.

The filming session is for a print and TV ad campaign for a new Polo/Ralph Lauren fragrance, “Big Pony Girls.”

The total crew, including TV and print, clients and cast, was 125 people. A large tent was erected at the middle school and the team used the

school cafeteria to serve breakfast and lunch throughout the week.

The shoot's producer, in an e-mail to the selectmen's office, promised to hire Duxbury police officers to assist with traffic during the shoot.
