## **DBA Hosts Preview of Ellison Center for the Arts**

Mark your calendars now to attend the annual DBA dinner meeting on Thursday, March 30. It is to be held at The Great China Restaurant at the Marketplace. Social hour will be from 6 to 7, with a Chinese buffet dinner at 7. There will be a short business meeting after dinner, followed by a presentation by representatives from the Ellison Center for the Performing Arts. They wish to apprise the business community on the progress of the Center, which will be in the former Holy Family Church and to discuss the positive impact it will have on Duxbury. Countless people will be coming to the Center, and in the process, "discovering" Duxbury and seeing what it has to offer in historic and business attractions. The cost of the meal (\$8.95 for one representative of an attending business) will be paid by the DBA, and the social hour (wine and soft beverage) will be provided by the Ellison Center.

Proposed business promotions for the year, similar to those held in 1994, will be discussed. Non-retail business members of the DBA are encouraged to come up with promotional ideas for their own types of businesses, which would be promoted through the DBA.

A new edition of the Discover Duxbury Map will be published this spring. DBA member locations will be identified on the map, with a short description of their business, as before. The previous map was highly successful.

Dues for 1995 will be \$75, assuming member renewal and new member signup is sufficient. At present, 2 Discover, Support and Shop Duxbury promotions are planned which will provide free advertising for DBA members. Costs incurred for publishing the new map will also be included in the dues fees. It is hoped that additional promotional ideas will be suggested at the meeting.
