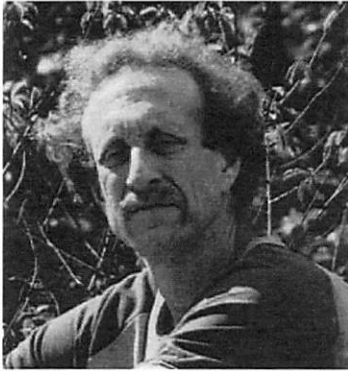


Douglas Mark Worthman, 64
