Drunk Teen Breaks into House

A 13-year-old boy is facing felony breaking and entering charges following an alcohol-related incident on Spruce Lane.

Duxbury police responded to a 911 caller reporting an intruder in her house at 11:25 p.m. on Monday, according to Lt. Chip Chubb.

The boy was found in the house by police after a search and appeared to be heavily intoxicated according to Lt. Chubb.

The 13-year-old was transported to the hospital and treated for alcohol intoxication. He was later released.

A second teenager, also 13, was reportedly involved in the incident but was not found in the house. He was not

charged.

One of the boys reportedly threw up in the back of the police cruiser.

No damage to the house was reported. The intruder may have entered through an unlocked door, police said.

The homeowner, who did not wish to be identified, said she was asleep when she first heard the disturbance.

"I saw a shadow walking through the halfway. It was scary," she said.

The homeowner said the boys, who live in the same neighborhood, had trespassed on her property about a year ago. She was upset that no one had come forward to apologize for the incident.

"It's terrible," she said.
