

Duxbury man killed in Cape scooter accident

A Duxbury man injured in a scooter accident in Bourne last week died of his injuries in a Boston hospital.

Kevin T. Barclay, 52, was riding a moped through the West End rotary, near the Massachusetts Maritime Academy the morning of June 11 when a car entered the rotary and hit him, a Bourne fire official said.

Barclay died Monday.

Police and fire officials requested a medical helicopter, but all helicopters were grounded that day because of the weather, a Bourne

fire official said.

Barclay was taken to Tobey Hospital in Wareham with life-threatening injuries, then transferred to Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston.

The Cape Cod Times reported the driver of the car, Heather MacDonald, 53, of West Dennis, entered the rotary without yielding.

MacDonald was charged with motor vehicle homicide, operating a motor vehicle negligently so as to endanger and failure to yield. She will be summoned to Falmouth District Court.
