

Film documentary at library

DUXBURY – Genetically modified organisms (GMOs) are in the U.S. food supply. Will their use eradicate world hunger as Monsanto stipulates? If so, why are GMOs banned in Europe? Are GMOs contributing to rising disease rates in the U.S. in areas such as allergies, inflammatory diseases, and gastrointestinal disorders, especially in children?

At 7 p.m. Friday, April 5, the film documentary *Genetic Roulette*, by best-selling author Jeffrey Smith, will be shown in the Merry Room of the Duxbury Free Library. Author John Robbins notes the film is "more than an adventure story with intense drama and high stakes.... meticulously documented, thoroughly comprehensive, and rivetingly presented."
