### FREDERICK B. KNAPP

In the death of Mr. Frederick B. Knapp the fire fighting forces of Duxbury have lost a staunch friend and supporter.

Mr. Knapp was a pioneer in the work of fire protection, being a member of the first Board of Fire Engineers and the first to hold the office of Chief Engineer.

He was elected to the office of Chief Engineer in 1906 and retired in 1911.

His interest in Forestry as well as fire protection made him especially well fitted for the office of Chief and Forest Warden.

After his retirement from office his interest and ardor continued and often furnished inspiration for those carrying on the work.

Never a seeker of public office he was always a tireless supporter of movements for the improvement of the town he loved.
