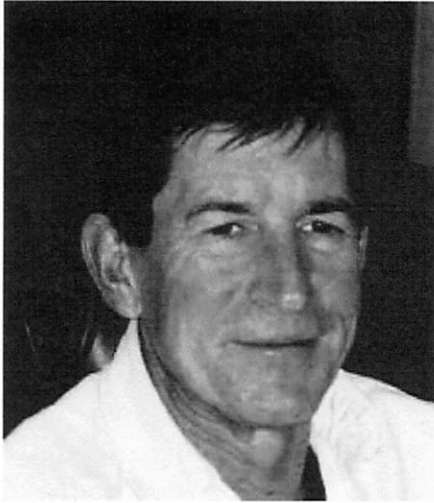


George E. Chandler, 57
