## Grace LeBart, 90

Grace (Barricklow) LeBart, 90, died Dec. 24, 2014, at The Terraces in Orleans. She was the wife of the late Frank LeBart, to whom she was married for 63 years. Mrs. LeBart was born on January 16, 1924, in Columbus, Ohio, and graduated from Denison University with a degree in economics. While at Denison, she joined the Delta Gamma sorority, and in 1988 she became involved with Philanthropic Educational Organization (PEO). She remained an active lifetime member of both organizations.

Mrs. LeBart and her husband Frank started their family in Boston, with a short stint in California at the end of the Korean War, living in married housing Quonset huts while Frank was in the Navy. After that, they raised their two sons in New Providence, N.J., before returning to Massachusetts and becoming active community members in Sudbury, and then Duxbury, for many years.

Mrs. LeBart was a generous, caring woman, devoted to her family, her friends and her church. She was a den mother for the Cub Scouts, an active PTA member and a First Reader at the First Church of Christ Scientist in Summit, N.J. She was strong and wise and could be counted on always for her steadfast support, beautiful smile, loving hugs and amazing cookies.

She was very close to her sister Mary Jeanne Bohannon, who predeceased her by less than a month. She is survived by her beloved sons and daughters-in-law, Todd LeBart and his wife Holly of Wellfleet and Don LeBart and his wife Gail of Annandale, N.J.

She was the devoted grandmother of Todd LeBart Jr. and his wife Anne of W. Milford, N.J., Justin LeBart and his wife Lindsay of Bend, Ore., Danielle Olszewski and her husband Scott of Bend, Ore., Nicholas LeBart of Wellfleet and the late Louie LeBart.
