



TRAILBLAZING

The town of **Duxbury** received nearly \$5,000 in state grant money last week to help improve a seven-mile stretch of the Bay Circuit Trail.

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Management awarded the money to the town as part of a continuing effort to maintain and revitalize the Bay Circuit Trail, a 200-mile semicircle of walking trails through Greater Boston.

When completed, the trail will provide an uninterrupted stretch of walking, biking, and horseback riding trails from Newburyport to **Kingston**.

Planners hope to use the money to install signs, trail maps and boxes along the Duxbury portion of the trail. Downed trees and limbs from last month's blizzard also will be cleared away.

The Duxbury section of the Bay Circuit Trail runs from the Bay Farm area to the **Pembroke** line.
