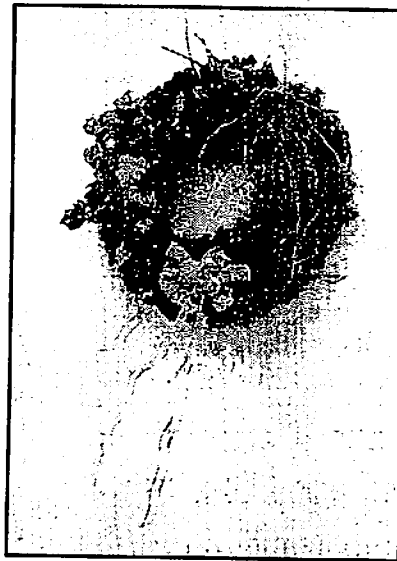




Standish Shore residents gather for the annual Christmas tree lighting and carol singing at Helen Hunt Park.

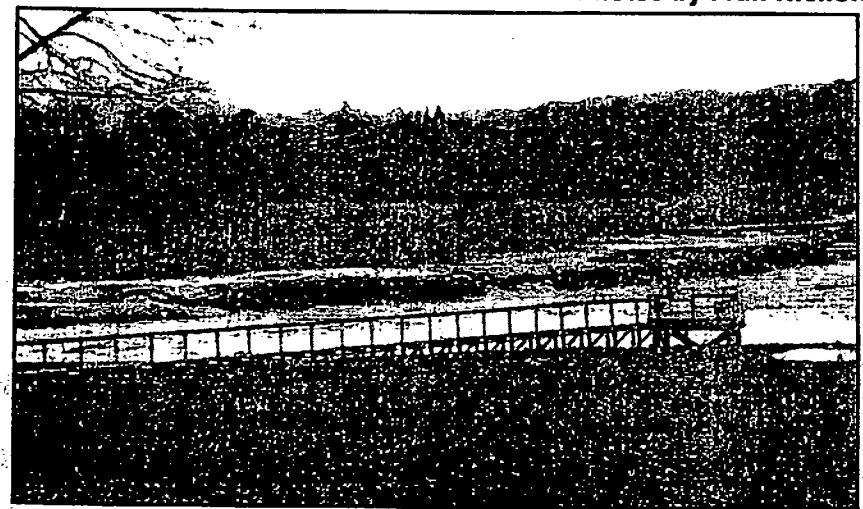

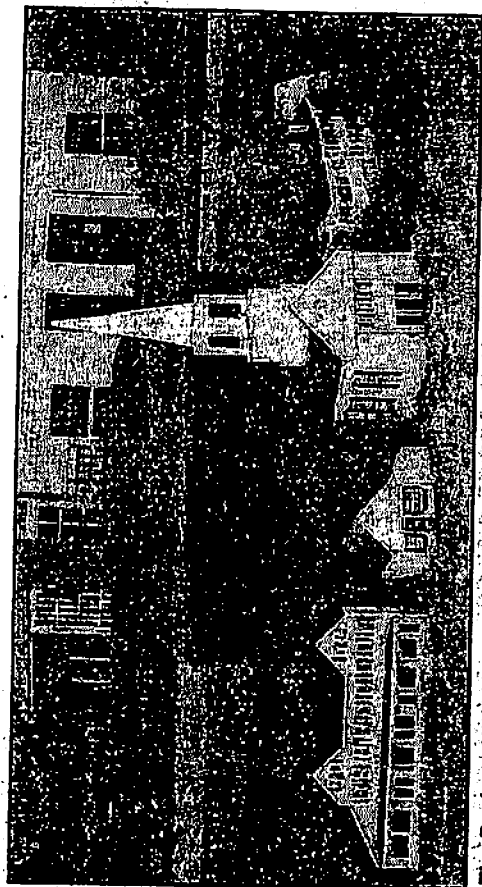

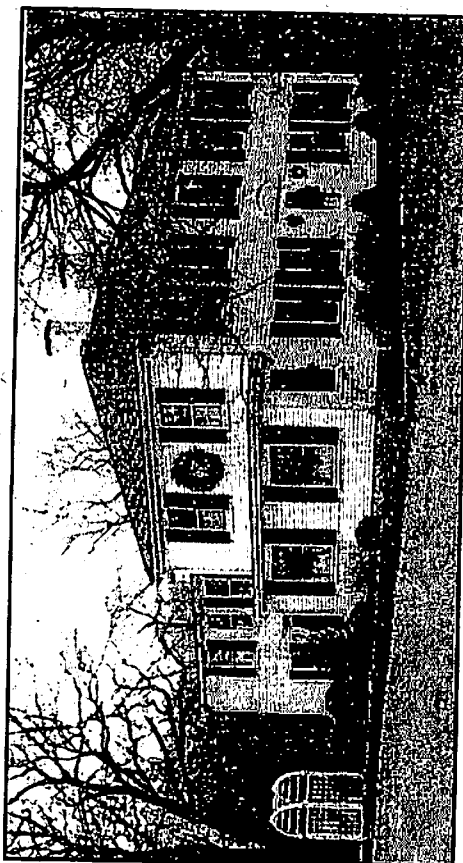

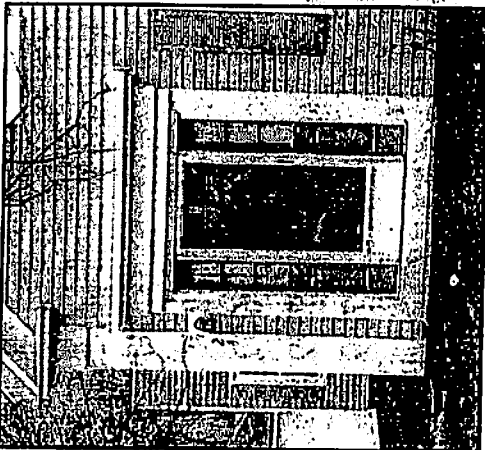

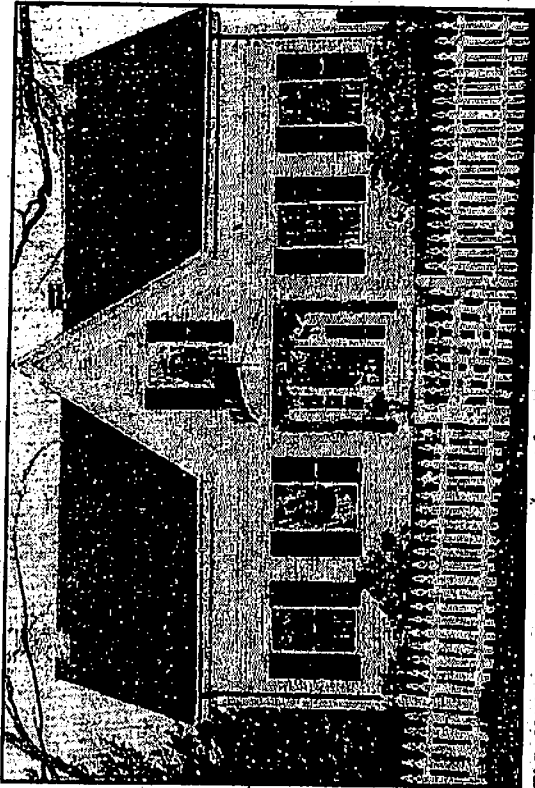
This house on the Bluefish River has a Christmas wreath on every window.



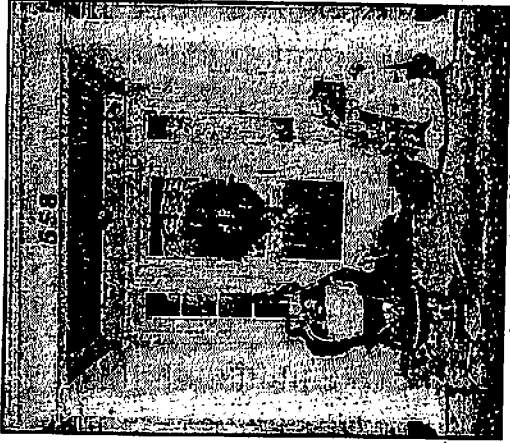
