INVITATION FOR BIDS

for the Construction of an Addition and Alterations to the

DUXBURY PUBLIC LIBRARY

For the Town of Duxbury, Massachusetts

The Town of Duxbury, represented by its Library Building Committee, The Awarding Authority, will receive sealed bids for the construction of an addition and alterations of a Public Library on St. George St., Duxbury, Massachusetts.

All bidding procedures shall be in strict accordance with the General Laws, Chapter 149, as amended, through Chapter 609 of the Acts of 1964.

Sub-bids shall be filed with the Awarding Authority not later than 3:00 P.M., June 20, 1967, at the Office of the Architect, Morehouse Chesley and Thomas, 18 Muzzey Street, Lexington, Massachusetts - 02173, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

General bids shall be filed with the Awarding Authority at the selectmen's Office, Town Offices, St. George St., Duxbury, Massachusetts, no later than 3:00 P.M., June 27, 1967 at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

General bids and sub-bids shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of cash or a certified check on, or a treasurer's or cashier's check issued by a responsible bank or trust company, payable to the Town of Duxbury, Massachusetts.

The bid deposit for General bidders shall be in the amount of \$10,000.

The bid deposit for sub-bidders shall be in the amounts as follows:

Bids may be withdrawn prior to the times respectively established for receipt of sub-bids and general bids only on written request to the Awarding Authority received prior to said respectively established times. No bid may be withdrawn after such times.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum wage rates as set forth in the General Conditions of the Contract shall be paid on this project. Attention is also called to the requirements relating to Workmen's Compensation and conditions of employment and to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Standards cited under the General Conditions.

Contract Documents, including drawings and specifications, are on file at the office of the Architect, Morehouse Chesley and Thomas, 18 Muzzey Street, Lexington 73, Massachusetts and F. W. Dodge Corporation, 858 Park Square Building, Boston 16, Massachusetts and at Gainey's Newsletter.

General Contractors or Subcontractors may obtain one copy each of the documents from the Architect by depositing fifty dollars (\$50.00) in cash or in the form of a certified check, payable to the Town of Duxbury, Massachusetts.

Deposits by bidders will be refunded upon return of the documents in good condition within ten days after the opening of bids. Non-bidders will be refunded one-half of the amount of the deposit upon return of the documents in good condition within ten days after opening of bids.

The Town of Duxbury, Massachusetts, reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informalities in bidding, if it be in the public interest so to do.
