John Merry, 86, designed North Hill

John E. Merry, 86, of Ossipee, N.H., formerly of Duxbury, died Saturday, April 28. He was born June 13, 1920 in Duxbury, the son of the late Hortence and Laura (Duff) Merry. He had lived in Duxbury for many years and was a graduate of DHS. In the early 1970s he moved to Wolfeboro, N.H. where he lived until moving to Ossipee more than 20 years ago.

Mr. Merry was a self-employed excavation contractor for most of his life. He designed, built and operated the North Hill Country Club in Duxbury. He also owned and operated Ossipee Equipment in Ossipee.

He leaves his sons John E. Merry Jr., of Hull; Richard Merry and his wife Holly, of Halifax; and Ron Merry and his wife Ann, of West

Brookfield, and his daughter Eleanor Kruskie, of Raleigh, N.C. He also leaves a brother, Stanley Merry, of Duxbury, and a sister, Alma Tatum, of Old Lyme, Conn., 12 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
