

Juliette Fay to Visit Duxbury

Juliette Fay, author of the critically acclaimed novel "The Shortest Way Home," will be at the Duxbury Free Library on Wednesday, April 10 at 7 p.m. for a reading and a book signing. This event is part of Westwinds Bookshop and The Duxbury Free Library Night Light series. "The Shortest Way Home" is also the Westwinds daytime drop-in book club pick this month.

"The Shortest Way Home" was chosen as one of Library Journal's top five "Best Books of 2012: Women's Fiction." Juliette's first novel, "Shelter Me," was a 2009 Massachusetts Book Award "Must-Read Book," a Target Bookmark Club selection and on the American Booksellers Association's Indie Next list. Her second, "Deep Down True," was short-listed for the Women's Fiction award by the American Library Association. Juliette received a bachelor's degree from Boston College and a master's degree from Harvard University. She lives in Massachusetts with her husband and four children.
