When the Sept. 24 signing of construction contracts by town and company officials, renovation of Upper Alden into the new Duxbury Free Library formally began.

Project contractors Joseph Slotnik Michelson and David Michelson from the J. Slotnik Company of Newton participated in the signing, along with Town

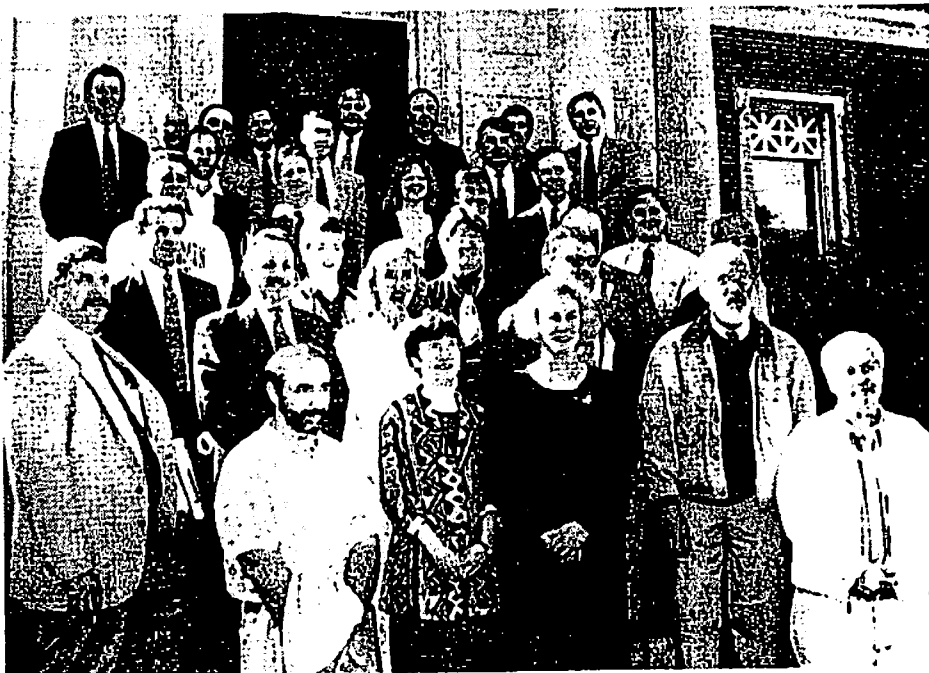

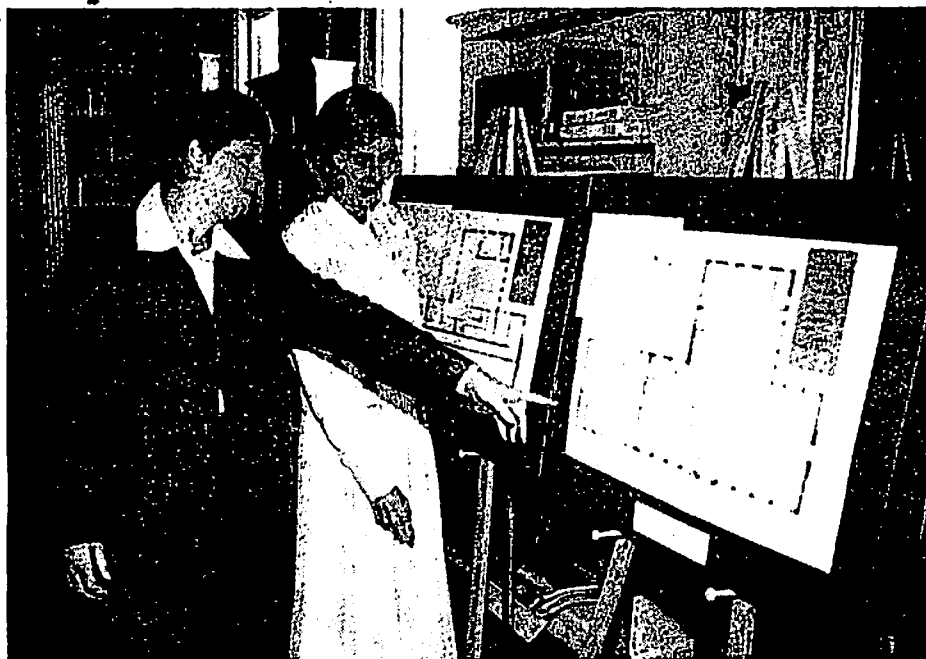
