Man drowns in bay

DUXBURY — An unfortunate start to the summer occurred early Wednesday evening in Duxbury Bay, as a 34-year-old man from Lynn drowned while trying to escape the scorching heat.

According to Fire Chief Kevin Nord, the man was discovered by a bystander at Powder Point Bridge. The victim was floating along the water when he was rescued and brought to shore. He was given CPR by someone on the scene until police and fire personnel arrived.

Duxbury paramedics administered advanced life support and transported the man to Jordon Hospital where he was pronounced dead.

According to Nord, it appeared the man was floating in an inner tube and got into water over his head. At this time they are unsure of how he ended up drowning.

Nord said that a full response was deployed including a dive team. At this time, the incident is still under investigation.
